Worldwide business revenue, including technology development, product development, and technology commercialization, totaled \$1.3 billion in FY'03.

During FY'03, there were 3,615 projects in progress at Battelle for 933 government and industrial clients.

In 2003, *R&D Magazine* selected 11 developments from Battelle, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, Oak Ridge National Laboratory, Brookhaven National Laboratory, and the National Renewable Energy Laboratory among the 100 most significant new products worldwide.

Battelle's all-time total R&D 100 Awards reached 117.

In FY'03, 142 Battelle staff were named on 99 patents, 74 of which were issued to Battelle, and 292 Battelle staff were honored for their efforts in technology development and commercialization.
