Summary

The scope of this contract is to perform tasks including studies, technical investigations, research, development, experimentation, limited acquisition, and logistics support for items and systems supporting the upgrade and modernization of U.S. Army, U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM), Department of Defense (DoD), and other Government Agency capabilities. The contract provides a mechanism to support customer needs in the areas of expeditionary warfare, irregular warfare, special operations, and stabilization/reconstruction operations.
