Our staff members provide support for laboratory diagnostics, influenza diagnostic test development and manufacturing, epidemiology and surveillance, pandemic preparedness, virus optimization for vaccine production, data computational analysis, quality management and non-influenza support.

Achieving Public Health Impact through Research (APHIR): Laboratory Support for Division of Laboratory Sciences, NCEH

Battelle provides laboratory support to the Division of Laboratory Sciences, National Center for Environmental Health and CDC since 1999. We provide highly skilled technical experts in the area of analytical chemistry to applied research and examine various aspects of human exposure to environmental hazards and threats. Some areas of focus are nutritional indicators; tobacco constituents and biomarkers; radiological, biological and chemical terrorism preparedness and response; and sample logistics throughout the division.

Battelle provides laboratory and logistical support to the CASPIR facility, housing over 6.5 million samples, we provide expertise in the areas of inventory, maintenance, management, retrieval and delivery of biological specimens. We collect, accession and maintain specimen data using the Specimen Inventory Management System (SIMS), maintain liquid nitrogen and mechanical freezers, and procure cryogens.
