Student Paper Competition Submission Form

Thank you for your interest in submitting a paper for the student paper competition. A student who already has submitted an abstract to be considered for the Conference program may also submit a paper for the competition, on either the same or a different topic. Receipt of each paper will be acknowledged within one week. Late submissions and papers that do not adhere to the format specifications may be disqualified.

The primary author of each winning paper will receive:

- Complimentary nontransferable Conference registration.
- A cash award to assist with travel costs. The cash award is intended to assist the winner(s) with travel and hotel costs; therefore, he or she must attend the Conference and present his or her work in order to receive the award.
- Placement in the Conference program as a poster or platform presentation (if not already placed as a result of having submitted an abstract in response to the Call for Abstracts).
- Award of commemorative plaque during the Plenary Session.
- Opportunity to include the paper in the Conference proceedings, if desired.

Eligibility. An individual may submit only one paper, and winners of student paper competitions at past Battelle conferences are not eligible. The primary author must (a) be a full-time student at the time the paper is submitted and (b) give the corresponding poster or platform presentation at the Conference. Faculty advisors may be listed as co-authors, but the Conference presentation must be made by the student.

Scope and Review Criteria. Papers may be submitted on any topic within the **technical scope** of the Conference. All papers submitted by the due date will be reviewed by a committee of experts. Review criteria will include originality of the research, thoroughness of the technical approach, validity of data interpretation, readability, and relevance to the overall scope of the Conference.

Format. The paper should be organized into the following sections: title, abstract, introduction, methods, results, conclusions, and references. To ensure objectivity in the review process, **do not include author names and affiliations or an acknowledgments section**; both sections can be added to the winning papers before they are published in the proceedings.

Papers should not exceed 10 pages; the page count includes figures, tables, and references. Document settings should be single-spaced, 11-point, Arial type, and 1.25-inch left/right margins.

Submission. Papers are to be submitted as Microsoft Word® documents. If the manuscript is on the same topic as an abstract that was submitted by the student or a colleague to be considered for the Conference technical program, the title of that abstract and the name of its corresponding/presenting author will need to be entered on page 2. All competition participants will be informed of the results in November 2017. Address questions on submission procedures to chlorcon@battelle.org.

Please follow the instructions below for the presentation option you prefer:

- **I want my paper to be considered for the Conference technical program.**
 - Please **submit an abstract** through the online submission by the August 31, 2017, due date. If past August, 31, 2017, please contact the Conference Office (chlorcon@battelle.org) for abstract submission instructions. If accepted, abstracts may be scheduled for platform or poster presentation whether or not you win the competition.
 - Fill out pages 2-3 of this form and return it and your paper to chlorcon@battelle.org.
- **I do not want my paper to be considered for the Conference technical program, only the student paper competition.**
 - Do not submit an abstract through the online submission. Your paper will not be considered for presentation in the technical program, it will only be reviewed for the student paper competition. However, if you win the competition, you will be required to present your paper in order to receive the award.
 - Fill out pages 2-3 of this form and return it and your paper to chlorcon@battelle.org.

Remediation Journal Publication Eligibility. The winning paper will be eligible for publication in the **Remediation Journal**, which focuses on sharing information on effective remediation approaches and techniques. Publication is not guaranteed and is at the sole discretion of the Remediation Journal. The author may also decline to submit the winning paper for publication. Additional formatting/editing of the winning paper may be required to fit the Journal's requirements. The winning author will be contacted by a representative of the Journal to discuss any additional publication terms and conditions.

Student papers are due October 13, 2017.
